The candidate must:

1. be a person of good character and standing in the community (an interview may be required).
2. have applied for admission to Bowie State University for the upcoming Fall semester.
3. provide a sealed copy of their most recent official transcript with the scholarship application.
4. have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or greater.

In addition, award recipients are strongly encouraged to attend the Montgomery County Chapter of the Bowie State University National Alumni Association, Inc.'s Scholarship Luncheon Gala in the Spring of the following year.
